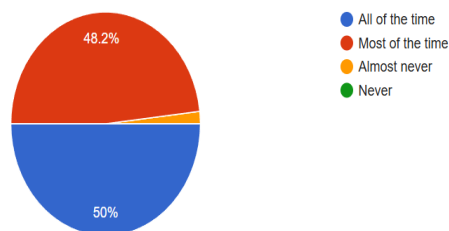


Parental Questionnaire Spring 2026- Feedback

56 responses



Out of **56 responses** **28 people** said their child **likes school ALL OF THE TIME.**

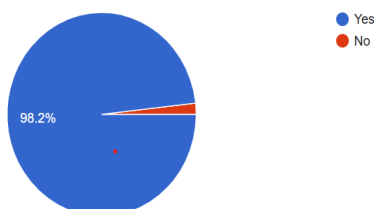
27 people said their child **likes school MOST OF THE TIME.**

1 person responded **ALMOST NEVER.**

56 responses



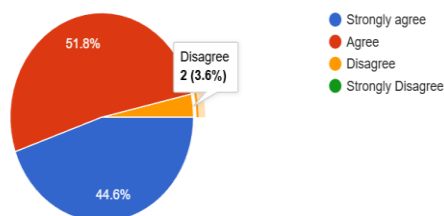
Out of **56 responses** **55 people** said they felt their child/ children were well supported when transitioning into the school or moving classes.

Only 1 person felt this did not happen.

56 responses



25 of the responses said they **strongly agreed** their child has always been supported with any additional needs.

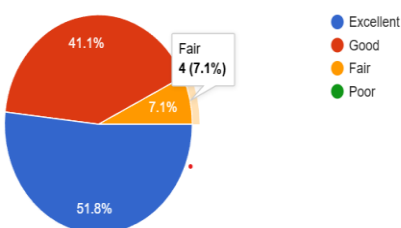
29 of the responses agreed that their child had been supported well.

2 responses disagreed with this statement. From looking at the comments, we can only see one related to ensuring girls with ADHD are acknowledged and catered for. This is something that is important to us too.

There were many lovely comments about the strong support pupils have received.

How would you rate the Leadership and Management of the school?

56 responses



29 of the responses felt Leadership and Management **was excellent.**

23 of the responses felt Leadership and Management was **Good.**

4 of the responses felt that Leadership and Management was **fair.**

No-one felt that the **Leadership and Management of the school was poor.**

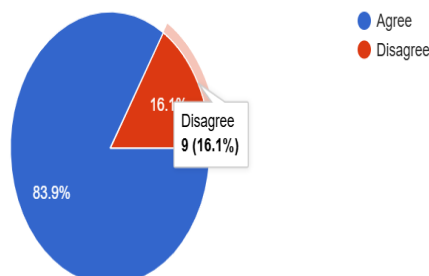
There were many lovely comments about families appreciating SLT being visible around the school and how SLT are moving the school forward.

56 responses



47 responses stated they felt they were well informed of how their child was getting on in school.

9 respondents disagreed with this.

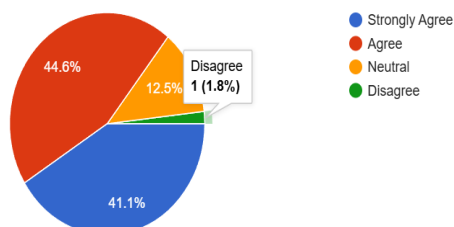
We always try keep our parents as informed as is possible. We hold parents' evenings in both the Autumn and Spring Term and will be offering a 'Sharing Our Learning' experience in the Summer Term. This will be for pupils to share their books and online learning accounts with families.

We operate an open-door policy where all parents/ carers can speak to teaching staff on the door if it is brief. For a longer discussion email admin and a member of staff will give you a ring. We will always get back to you. If there were concerns or significant changes in your child's progress or wellbeing staff would always get in touch with you. Staff would not wait for a parents evening to discuss these.

We also offer our INNOVATE sessions for families to attend in the Spring Term to engage with your child's learning.

The school values my views and feedback?

56 responses



23 responses stated they strongly agreed that school values their views.

25 responses agreed that their views were valued.

7 responses were neutral regarding this question.

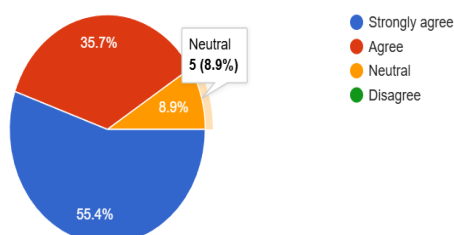
1 response disagreed and felt their values and views were not valued.

We are keen to express we absolutely value our families' views. This year we have undertaken an initial parental view survey and a wellbeing-based survey during parents' evenings. Both have had the results analysed and we have implemented change due to these comments. We also provide weekly coffee mornings for parents to share their views and a monthly 'Cuppa with the Headteacher' which provides parents with an ongoing opportunity to share their feedback.

Examples where we have valued our family feedback include us adapting our 'Innovate' sessions and broadening our extra-curricular experiences. We have also adapted parts of our curriculum from parental suggestions.

The school keeps families informed and communicates well?

56 responses



31 responses stated they strongly agreed that school informs and communicates well with them.

20 responses agreed they felt the school communicated well with them.

5 responses answered neutral.

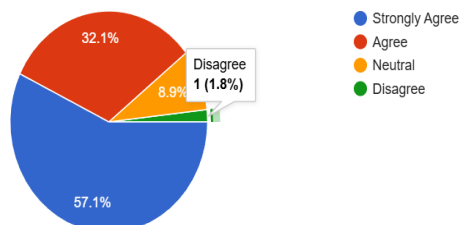
No-one disagreed that the school communicates well with them. This is so pleasing. In our Autumn questionnaire families had commented on previous experiences of not being communicated to clearly. The weekly newsletter has really supported this and that is why we emphasise the importance of this being read every week. From this feedback it is evident improvements have been made.

32 responses strongly agreed that we are providing a good range of additional experience.

18 responses agreed with the statement

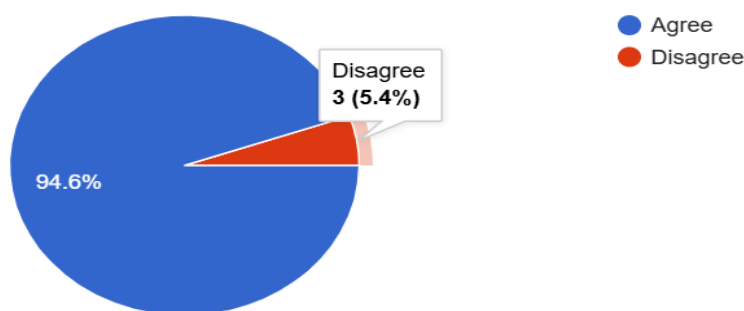
5 responses were neutral

This is one area we have worked hard to improve. We now have a full timetable of extra-curricular activities, and these include a range to suit different interests. We are keen to involve the Early Years pupils in opportunities and will be implementing in the Summer Term. We recently conducted a pupil voice questionnaire which showed many of our pupils are enjoying all the additional opportunities we are providing in school. We have ensured trips and visits are an important part of our curriculum but need to be mindful of the cost implication for our families.

Out of the 56 respondents 53 of our families said they would RECOMMEND Ogmore Vale Primary to another parent. This is such a compliment to the school.

3 responses stated they would not recommend the school. In the linked comments 1 of these was linked to support for Additional Learning Needs, another regarding some negative previous experiences and the third did not comment why.

With regards to supporting pupils with Additional Learning Needs we have had many comments about how pleased families are with the support their child has received at the school. We do not wish for any of our families to have bad experiences or feel we haven't catered for their child. We would always encourage any families who feel we could do better to get in touch with us regarding their child's progress.

We had such lovely compliments in the final section of the survey and feel a huge sense of pride. The feedback has been shared with staff during a staff meeting. Thank you to everyone who took part, and I hope that sharing the raw data with families will show our transparent approach to understanding and valuing parental views and feedback.
